

2025 GINGERBREAD INVITATIONAL

The Rockwell Museum is pleased to announce the **11 th Annual Gingerbread Invitational** – a fun, artful gingerbread competition for baking enthusiasts and community members of all skill levels.

We invite you to enter your innovative design for the chance to be one of **(up to) 12 artists** featured in a special holiday exhibition.

In 2025, the theme is "COLOR!" inspired by the Museum's <u>annual theme</u>. From bold rainbows to subtle shades to chic monochrome, we invite you to let your imagination run wild to bring your vibrant, colorful creations to life. Museum visitors and community members will vote for their favorite creations; a winner will be announced in early January 2026.

HOW IT WORKS

- Interested individuals/teams must submit their application, including a design sketch, by Monday, October 20, 2025. It's important to follow all of the size and materials specifications (see page 3).
- **Up to 12 submissions** will be selected to be featured in the *Gingerbread Invitational*. Each artist/team will then have approximately 1 month to create their design and drop it off at The Rockwell Museum on the designated date.
- At drop-off, each team will be awarded a \$50 honorarium in the form of a VISA gift card to help compensate them for their materials.
- Artists/teams will have the opportunity to present their work to the public at a special exhibition night on December 3, 2025. This will be your chance to share your gingerbread creations with visitors and schmooze for votes!
- Throughout the exhibition, visitors to The Rockwell will vote for their favorite gingerbread creations. The winner of the *Community Choice Award* will be announced in January 2026.



PRIZES

- All participants will receive thank-you honorariums in the form of a \$50 VISA gift card and ceramic medallions created by local artist Colleen McCall.
- **Community Choice Award Winner** will receive a \$500 gift card, plus a Ceramic Trophy created by Colleen McCall.

GINGERBREAD INVITATIONAL: ENTRY GUIDELINES

Please read these specifications carefully for the most successful experience

- Any structure/sculpture that fits the theme of "Color!" is eligible.
- Be creative and have fun! In your design, consider originality, overall appearance, creative use of materials and overall complexity of design.
- The construction must not exceed 20"x20"x20" and must be freestanding. The gingerbreads will be housed underneath plexi-glass vitrines and must adhere to the size requirements to fit on the pedestals.
- The entry should be created and delivered attached to a plywood or other sturdy base, not to exceed 20" x 20" x 20" enabling it to be freestanding. If needed, The Rockwell will provide a plywood base. Please note if you'd like us to provide the plywood base in your application. You will pick it up once your entry has been chosen.
- We require that you use the provided recipe for a very durable Royal Icing. Please keep in mind that your creation must last over a month, under our Museum lights. This recipe will help your creation stay together!
- Please, no pre-fabricated gingerbread kits. All visible components of the creation should be made from edible materials.
- Experience tells us that Jolly Ranchers, gelatin, and cotton candy DO NOT LAST under our hot museum lights. Please do not use these candies or similar ingredients in your creation.
- Electrical outlets cannot be provided. If you include lighting, it should be batteryoperated and hooked up to a timer so that it lasts the entirety of the exhibition.
- Entries must be picked up on January 2, 2026, between 12 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. Those not picked up will be discarded, unless other arrangements have been made.
- The Rockwell Museum reserves the right to remove any displays that fall apart during the exhibition.



ROYAL ICING RECIPE

Yields 2 Cups Royal Icing*

3 egg whites ½ teaspoon cream of tartar 1 lb. Confectioner's sugar

Beat at high speed 7 to 10 minutes. Icing is ready to use when knife drawn through it leaves a clear path that holds its shape.

*Do not double the recipe. If additional icing is needed, make separate batches.
