

## SIXTH ANNUAL GINGERBREAD INVITATIONAL

The Rockwell Museum is pleased to announce the **Sixth Annual Gingerbread Invitational** – a fun, artful gingerbread competition for baking enthusiasts and community members of all skill levels.

We invite you to enter your innovative design for the chance to be **one of (up to) 12 artists** featured in a special holiday exhibition. This year, Rockwell programming and exhibitions revolve around the theme of *Advancing Women*. In this spirit, design a gingerbread creation inspired by a woman historical figure, author, character or architect!

We encourage you to think outside the box for this year's challenge, and be sure to tell us about your inspiration in your application!

### HOW IT WORKS – PLEASE NOTE SOME IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THIS YEAR'S PROGRAM

- Interested individuals/teams must submit their application, including a design sketch, by October 21, 2020. It's important to follow all of the size and materials specifications (see page 3).
- **Up to 12 submissions** will be selected to be featured in *The Gingerbread Invitational*. Each artist/team will then have approximately 1 month to create their design, and drop it off at The Rockwell Museum on the designated date.
- At drop-off, each team will be awarded a \$50 honorarium in the form of a VISA gift card to help compensate them for their materials.
- Throughout the exhibition, visitors to The Rockwell will vote on their favorite gingerbread creations – the winner of the *Community Choice Award* will be announced toward the end of the exhibition.
- Please note: Due to social distancing guidelines, we are not able to host an exhibition opening reception this year. However, Holiday Open House (free admission) has been extended to two weekends to ensure you can show off your creation to your family and friends.

### PRIZES

- **All participants** will receive thank-you honorariums in the form of a \$50 VISA gift card, plus swag bags featuring gifts from the Museum Store and ceramic medallions created by local artist Colleen McCall.  
**Community Choice Award Winner** – \$250 + Ceramic Trophy by Colleen McCall

<b>Saturday, November 21, 2020</b>	Exhibition open to the public. Public voting launches!
<b>Saturdays &amp; Sundays December 5 &amp; 6, 2020 December 12 &amp; 13, 2020 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.</b>	Holiday Open House. Free admission for all ages, all weekend.
<b>Thursday, December 31, 2020</b>	Final day of exhibition. Community Choice Winner Announced.

## GINGERBREAD INVITATIONAL: ENTRY GUIDELINES

*Please read these specifications carefully for the most successful experience*

- Any structure/sculpture that fits the theme of "Advancing Women" is eligible
- **Be creative and have fun!** In your design, consider originality, overall appearance, creative use of materials and overall complexity of design.
- The construction must not exceed 20"x20"x20" and must be freestanding. The gingerbreads will be housed underneath plexi-glass vitrines and must adhere to the size requirements in order to fit.
- The entry should be created and delivered attached to a plywood or other sturdy base, not to exceed 20"x20"x20", enabling it to be freestanding. If needed, The Rockwell will provide a plywood base. Please note your request in your application. You will pick it up once your entry has been chosen.
- We require that you use the provided recipe for a very durable Royal Icing. Please keep in mind that your creation must last over a month - this recipe will help your creation stay together!
- Please, no pre-fabricated gingerbread kits. All visible components of the creation should be edible.
- Experience tells us that Jolly Ranchers DO NOT LAST under our hot museum lights. Please do not use Jolly Ranchers and similar candies in your display.
- Electrical outlets cannot be provided. If you include electric lighting, it should be battery-operated and be able to last the entirety of the exhibition.
- Entries must be picked up on January 4, 2021, between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Those not picked up will be discarded, unless other arrangements have been made.
- The Rockwell Museum reserves the right to remove any displays that fall apart during the exhibition.

## ROYAL ICING RECIPE

*Yields 2 Cups Royal Icing\**

3 egg whites  
½ teaspoon cream of tartar  
1 lb. Confectioner's sugar

Beat at high speed 7 to 10 minutes. Icing is ready to use when knife drawn through it leaves a clear path that holds its shape.

\*Do not double the recipe. If additional icing is needed, make separate batches.
